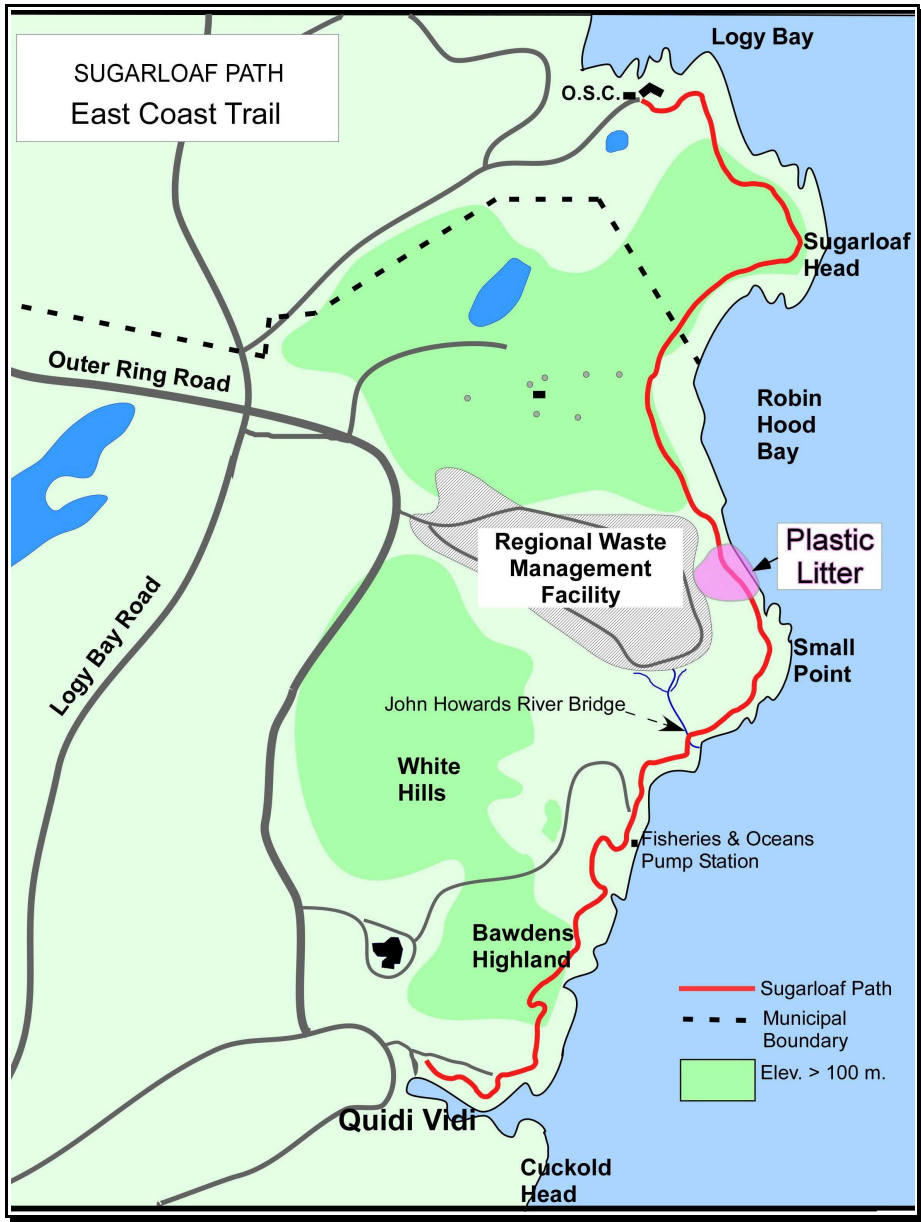


Where, exactly, is the litter problem on Sugarloaf Path?



Sugarloaf is the 19th path fully developed on the East Coast Trail. It is 8.9 km of rugged and stunningly beautiful coastline on the northern edge of St. John's, bordering the Town of Logy Bay-Middle Cove-Outer Cove.

Windblown plastic (see pink marking) can be found below the St. John's Sanitary Landfill.

The East Coast Trail Association leads volunteer cleanup hikes in this section of the path every season and the City of St. John's
